Vehicle Fleet Driving Safety

MAPP04.03.06

- A. This policy falls under the authority of the TSRUSes and Regulation chaptes IV and VII; the TexasState Vehicle Fleet Management Plan administered by the StatexasOffice of Vehicle Fleet Managemen (OVFM) the TexasGovernmentCode, Chapters2158, 2171, and 2175; and all other applicable federal, state, and TSUS laws, statutes, rules, and regulations
- III. SAFE DRIVING POLICIES
 - A. Only University sanctioned drivers are allowed to drive or operate LU's fleet vehicles. (For more information, see LU's ehicle Fleet Driver Selection Policy.)
 - B. Drivers who do not hold University driving privileges may not operate a University vehicle. LU employees who drive orperate a University vehicle without these privileges, or employees who allow an unsanctioned driver to operate a University vehicle, are subject to disciplinary action in keeping with the University's disciplinary policies and procedures.
 - C. University drivers shall obey all traffic laws. University drivers who are ticketed by state, local, or campus authorities for violations of traffic laws are required to pay their own fines, legal expenses,

requires driving, the employee may be subject to **perf**ancereview or disciplinary action in keeping with the University's Human Resources policies and procedures.
