I. POLICY

LamarUniversity's iscalyear (FY) begins September 1 and ends on the following August 31, both dates inclusive.

II. PURPOSÆNDSCOPE

This policy falls under the authority of the Texas State University System (TSUS) Rules and Regulations, the Texas Education Code, Title 3, including but not limited to Chapters 1 and 61; the Texas Administrative Code, Title 19, Part 1, and the Texas Government Code, Title 3, including but not limited to §§316.071072.

III. DEFINITION

Fiscal Year (FYThe period of time beginning September 1 and ending on the following August 31, both dates inclusive, which coincides with the State of Texas' fiscal year. (Texas Higher EducationCoordinating BoardGlossaryof Terms)

IV. PROCEDURES

Texasstatute mandatesthat state appropriations conform to the state's FY. In keeping with Texas statute, Lamar University's Annual Operating Budget ("budget") also conforms to the state's FY.

LamarUniversity's budget is labeled or known by the year in which a FYends. For example, the September 1, 2020-August 312021 budget is known as the FY2021 budget.

In keepingwith Texasstatute, Lamar University closes its account sand budget at the end of each FY.

After each FY closes, Lamar University prepares and submits any reports required by TSUS and the State of Texasregarding budget, expenditures, and other financial activity during that previous FY.
