If requested, materials not added to the collection will be returned to the donor. Materials that are donated without this completed form, including contact information, may be discarded. Materials added to the collection may be removed and discarded at a later date. Because of space limitations, the vast majority of unsolicited book donations are not added to the collection. By law, the Library cannot provide an appraisal of any donated material.
